Parents - Teacher's Meeting - After every periodic test, the ward's academic progress and participation in co-curriculum activities will be informed through parents teachers meeting.

ACADEMIC EVALUATION & ASSESSMENT :

The School has a system of continuous comprehensive assessment. There are three periodic test excluding final test. Due weightage is given to the Class Test (CT) Project, Speech etc. for subject enrichment as per CBSE rule.

***Test** of each chapter of every subject is taken regularly and **checked copies** are sent to the parents.

FOR PARENTS :

- ❖ School diary is a means of Communication with the teacher. The diary should be checked daily for home work and teacher's remark.
- ❖ Your child should have all the Text Books, note books etc. right from the beginning of the session.
- ❖ Ensure that your child comes to school in proper uniform with polished shoes, trimmed hair and nails.
- ❖ The child should be sent regularly and punctually to the school, no leave of absence will be permitted without an application and late comers will not be allowed to sit in the class.
- ❖ Fees should be paid as per schedule.
- ❖ Change in **Address** and **Telephone No.** should be intimated to the school office.

ADMISSION FOR (NUR. TO IX) :

Admission (from Nur. to IX) are granted purely on the basis of merit and ability of the child. The admission process starts from the 3rd week of January every year but registration starts from 1st week of Dec. every year; **Birth Certificate** and **Aadhar No.** are required at the time of admission. But **TC, Marksheet** and **Character Certificate** must submit upto 15th April in the **New Session**. Otherwise the admission will be **Cancelled**

Note - No test for admission to Nursery.
For Std. VIII & IX students should have 50% marks in the test.

*ACADEMY AND CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The School ensures that the prescribed curriculum is transacted most effectivity through use of educational technology and various subject teachers are kept constantly up-to-date through in service training, refresher courses and seminars etc.

In order to bring about multifaceted development of students intellectual, physical, social, emotional, moral and aesthetic, the academic programmes are supplemented with well planned co-curricular activities in which a wide range of inter-house competitions are organised. MODE OF ADMISSION :

Admission are granted purely on the basis of merit and ability of the child. Test and interview for the selection of students are conducted in the mid week of January every year. Registration for admission starts from 1st week of December every year. Birth certificate, T.C., Aadhar, Marksheet and character certificate require at the time of admission.

MODE OF PAYMENT :

School fees are payable monthly. However, parents can pay school dues for the whole year in advance right in the beginning of the academic session, if they so desire, school fees are payable upto the 10th day of the month concerned without fines. From 11th of the month the fine will be charged Rs. 100/-. If fees are not paid two months regularly the name of the pupil concerned will be struck off the school rolls and his re-admission will be purely at the discretion of the principal.

ATTENDANCE :

Irregular attendance, unjustified or unexplained absence, habitual late attendance, disobedience or objectionable behaviour of any kind may result in removal from the school. 90% of total number of working days is must for a student to be present.

Infrastructure

FACILITIES

The splendid ground and sprawling building of the school gives a unique characteristic of its own. All conceivable requirements for imparting quality education have been duly taken care through facilities outlined below :-

TRANSPORT

The School buses ply on routes which are being catered by a fleet of school buses. The School provides transport facilities in all routes. If the required number of students of a certain route are ready to take the facility.

COMPUTER CENTRE

Computer education is an integral part of the school curriculum. We take this opportunity to introduce informatics. Well-planned computer education programmes have been introduced for students from class 1 upwards. One spacious laboratory equipped with latest computer which are always kept in excellent state of maintenance, the availability of large variety of software and computer literature and above all our excellent team of computer science teachers provide a conducive environment for teaching learning of this discipline.

MUSIC AND DANCE DEPARTMENT

The facilities provided could be an envy of the best of school. Music and Dance are taught as art forms under experienced and reputed artists engaged to teach them. Requisite musical instruments have been provided.

SPORTS FACILITIES

The school has a spacious play field with sophisticated facilities for major team games such as Football, Volleyball, Cricket, Basketball, Khokho, Weight Lifting, Table Tennis etc.

PERSONALITY DEVELOPING PROGRAMME

Under this programme students of class VI & XII shall be involved in voluntary activities to develop personal qualities of self-reliance, perception and responsibility towards self and society. They shall be required to undertake activities in the following areas.

4. Physical recreation

MORAL EDUCATION

Special attention is given for moral orientation of the students. Besides formal education in moral science, pupils are provided an environment helping them moral values and traits in daily life.

HEALTH

A medical check-up of students is carried out by the medical officer once a year.

*OBJECTIONABLE BEHAVIOURS

Absence from class without valid reason, disobediences, late coming or any other objectionable behaviour by any student will be considered a very serious offence and the student concerned may be fined or summarily expelled.



General Rules

1. Every student should be in proper school uniform (neat and clean), else he or she shall not be permitted to attend the classes/assembly.
2. The Principal will meet parents and guardians on working days only. Time 9.00 to 11.00AM
3. All the complaints must be made in writing and be addressed to the principal and not to any other member of school.
4. Parents are not allowed to meet teachers and students without prior permission.
5. The price of the school furniture equipment, apparatus, glass panes of other school property damaged by student due to carelessness will be charged.
6. Parents should deem their duty to be present at a Parent - Teacher Meeting.
