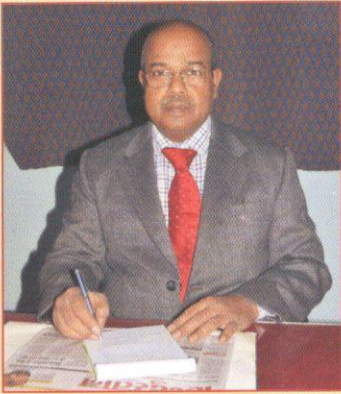

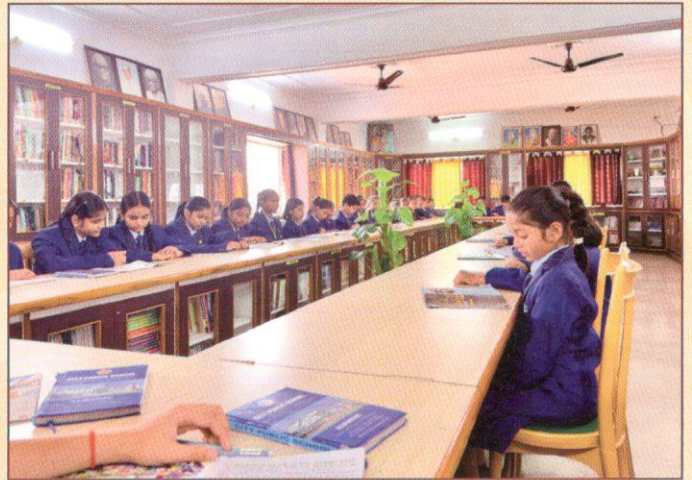
Admission

Admission (Nursery to IX)

- Admission (from Nursery to IX) is granted purely on the basis of merit and the ability of the child.
- The admission process starts from the third week of January every year, but registration starts from the first week of December.
- Birth Certificate, PEN, and Aadhar Card are required at the time of admission.
- T.C., Marksheet, and Character Certificate can be submitted up to 15th April of the new session; otherwise, admission will be cancelled.

Note :

- No test is required for admission to Nursery.
- Students applying for Std. VIII and IX must score a minimum of 50% in the entrance test.
- The admission process is completely based on merit.
- The admission and registration fees are non-refundable.



General Rules

1. Every student should be in proper school uniform (neat and clean); otherwise, he or she shall not be permitted to attend the classes or assembly.
2. The principal will meet parents and guardians on working days only, between 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m.
3. All complaints must be made in writing and addressed to the principal, not to any other member of the school.
4. Parents are not allowed to meet teachers and students without prior permission.
5. The price of school furniture, equipment, apparatus, glass panes, and other school property damaged by a student due to carelessness will be charged to them.
6. Parents should consider it their duty to be present at Parent-Teacher Meetings.

Academic Evaluation & Assessment

The school has a system of continuous and comprehensive assessment. There are two periodic tests excluding the midterm and final exams conducted during an academic session.

Due weightage is given to Class Tests (CT), Projects, and Subject Enrichment Activities as per CBSE guidelines.

Tests of each chapter of every subject are conducted regularly, and checked copies are sent to the parents.

For Parents :

- The school diary is a means of communication with the teacher. The diary should be checked daily for homework and the teacher's remarks.
- Your child should have all textbooks and notebooks from the beginning of the session.
- Ensure that your child comes to school in proper uniform, with polished shoes and trimmed hair and nails.
- The child should attend school regularly and punctually. No leave of absence will be permitted without an application, and latecomers will not be allowed to sit in class.
- Fees should be paid as per the schedule.
- Any change in address or telephone number should be intimated to the school office.

ATTENDANCE

Irregular attendance, unjustified or unexplained absence, habitual late coming, disobedience, or objectionable behaviour of any kind may result in removal from the school.

A minimum of 90% attendance of the total number of working days is mandatory for a student to be eligible to appear for examinations.

OBJECTIONABLE BEHAVIOUR

Absence from class without a valid reason, disobedience, late coming, or any other objectionable behaviour by any student will be considered a very serious offence. The student concerned may be fined or summarily expelled.

MODE OF PAYMENT

School fees are payable monthly. However, parents may pay school dues for the entire session in advance at the beginning of the academic year, if they so desire.

School fees are payable up to the 10th day of each month without a fine. From the 11th day onwards, a fine of Rs. 100/- per month will be charged.

If fees are not paid for two consecutive months, the name of the student concerned will be struck off the school roll, and re-admission will be purely at the discretion of the principal.

Dress Code :

School uniform is compulsory for all students on all school days, even during examinations and organized tours. Uniforms are stipulated as follows:
